National City Bank filed a declaratory judgment action requesting the Jefferson Circuit Court to answer seven questions. One of the questions was whether Virginia's children, beneficiaries of the trust, triggered the "no contest" provision of their mother's trust by challenging their step-father's right to withdraw five percent of the trust principal each year. The trial court entered a judgment on the pleadings holding that the three children's actions did not trigger the no contest provision.
