KERS argues that Haywood's appeal to the circuit court should have been barred because she did not file exceptions to the recommended findings of the hearing officer and that the hearing officer's findings were supported by substantial evidence. Haywood argues, in part, that KERS breached its fiduciary duty when it failed to notify her of any obligation to file exceptions to the hearing officer's findings.
